The current list of Governor/Trustee vacancies is as follows:

- **Dean** – require Foundation members
Foundation members have a particular role in upholding the church school status and are usually nominated by the parish's PCC. They do not have to be committed church goers but it does help if there have some good links with the parish church and are sympathetic to upholding the Christian faith. - **Montreal CofE Primary**, Cleator Moor - – 1 x Governor
- **Moor Row** – 1 x Governor
- **Frizington Community Primary**, Frizington – potentially filled
- **Northside Primary, Workington** – need more volunteers on their Local Advisory board (this is essentially the same as a governor but in an academy)
- **Westfield Primary, Workington** – want a parent governor but can appoint someone not linked to the school but with a school aged child
- **St Cuthbert's**, Wigton – require 1 x Foundation Governor, must be catholic
- **Holme St Cuthbert's**, Mawbray – 1 x co-opted Governor
- **Broughton Moor** - 1 x co-opted Governor
- **St Michael's CofE**, Bothel – require 1 x Foundation Governor – must have links to the church
- **Allonby** – require 1 x Governor plus clerks to governors
- **Oughterside** – require 1 x Governor
- **Crosscannonby** – require 1 x Co-opted and 1 x Parent Governor but can appoint someone not linked to the school but with a school aged child
- **St Matthew's CofE** – requires clerks to governors
- **Blennerhasset** - requires clerks to governors
- **St. Michael's Nursery and Infant**, Workington – require 1 enthusiastic governor
- **Eaglesfield Paddle** – require 2 governors, 1 with finance experience and one with legal &/or HR experience
- **St Mary's Catholic Primary school, Whitehaven** - one parent governor and four foundation governors at St Mary's Catholic Primary school in Whitehaven.
